

JAB bids farewell with arts event

GOSHEN — Musician and composer JAB presents a farewell performance event to the Midwest, "Veil/Reality: A Love Sonnet to the Midwest," from 5 p.m. to midnight Friday and Saturday at the Michiana Center for the Arts, 113½ E. Lincoln St.

A multimedia "art fun-house," the event features live and pre-recorded music, ambient sounds gathered from the Midwest, visuals, film, sculpture, theater, surprise, intrigue and the outdoors inside with leaves, cornstalks, and objects gathered from alleys, parks, rivers, etc.

Confirmed participants for "Veil/Reality" include JAB, sculptor Eric Ford from Iowa, guitarist Tim Hochstetler from Michigan, ambient noise guru Nathan Butler from Goshen and filmmaker Andrew J. Rogers from Chicago.

JAB founded and has been the director of the Michiana Center for the Arts through its first 14 months, and in that time has worked with local arts organizations and businesses to present more than 140 regional artists in visuals, music, theater,

He also has taught music in the Goshen and Concord school districts, been active in the Goshen College music scene, been featured as trumpet soloist with the Goshen High School Jazz Ensembles and has taught at TG School of Music in Goshen & The Music and Dance Academy in Middlebury.

JAB will soon embark on a three-month tour of the United States and then

move to Europe in early 2012.
